## LICENSING AT AEC

- 1. Fill and return completed notification form for any intended practice
- 2. Council receives the notification form and gives the client relevant application forms according to the notified practice.
- 3. Filled and completed application forms are returned to Council
- 4. Council within 30 days after receipt of application, verifies, assesses and reviews the application forms and the applicant is contacted in case of any missing or additional information.
- 5. Quotation (Invoice) is sent to the applicant
- 6. Upon honoring the invoice Council issues the applicant with the license/permit.

Note: The licensing/procedure according to the Atomic Energy Act, 2008 35 (3) takes a maximum of 90 days, but for a complete application, the process could take less time depending on the nature of the practice.
